- \$1,178 on the Fort Takapuna Heritage Project (refurbishment of barracks, battle of Passchendale museum and open space developments (2014 – 2015))
Library
- \$7,800 for the demolition of the old library and build of a new library (Devonport, 2015)
City Transformation
- \$1,111 in the commercial area (Takapuna-Hurstmere Green, 2013)
- \$4,952 on the boardwalk extension and marine square upgrade (Devonport, 2013 - 2015)
Parks, Sports and Recreation
- \$271,000 on the coastal walkway (Takapuna-Milford, 2012)
- \$2,400 in the Bayswater pipe bridge project (walking and cycle track over the storm water pipe bridge from Bayswater to Takapuna, 2013)
- \$7,588 on Victoria wharf including boat berthing facilities and scooter/bike parking (Devonport, 2013 – 2015)
Transport
- \$4,518 for the Lake Road infrastructure upgrades between Devonport and Takapuna (Esmonde to Jutland, 2011)
- \$1,615 on the Smales Farm project (business precinct and car parks, 2012)
- \$959 on Sunnynook Shopping Centre footpath improvements (2012)
