

## Drop off your household hazardous waste at the HazMobile

The HazMobile will operate in your area between 10am and 2pm on the following Saturdays:

• **31 March 2012**  
Green Bay High School carpark,  
143 - 161 Godley Road, Green Bay

• **14th April 2012**  
Public carpark on Motions Road,  
near the Zoo entrance and TAPAC, Western Springs

You can also drop off your household hazardous waste at the Waitakere Refuse Transfer Station seven days per week. (Limits and conditions apply)

### Household hazardous waste includes:

- ✓ Household chemicals such as cleaners and disinfectants
- ✓ Garden chemicals such as pesticides, herbicides and fungicides
- ✓ Car products such as petrol, oil\* and solvents
- ✓ Pool chemicals
- ✓ Batteries (all types)
- ✓ Glues
- ✓ Gas bottles/cylinders (all types).
- ✓ Lead-based paint and marine antifouling paint

### The HazMobile will not take:

- ✗ Enamel (oil based) or acrylic (water based) paint.

These types of paint and paint cans can be taken year round for reuse or recycling to Resene Colorshops (see [www.resene.co.nz/paintwise](http://www.resene.co.nz/paintwise)). At Resene Colorshops, Resene-branded paint is free to return. A small charge applies to other paint brands to cover handling, recovery and recycling costs. Conditions apply to the return of paint cans. Please see the Resene website for more details.

\* Household used engine oil can also be disposed of safely via free oil recovery bins around the region. Visit [www.oilrecycling.org.nz](http://www.oilrecycling.org.nz) for more information

# Introduction

Auckland Council's inorganic rubbish collection is for residential properties only.

Inorganic rubbish means items that are not suitable for the regular recycling collection, are too large for your refuse bag and are not hazardous such as:

- Furniture
- Computers, TVs
- Toys
- Metal items from household renovations (corrugated iron, pipes etc.)
- Appliances (washing machines, stoves, fridges)
- Lawn mowers, wheelbarrows
- Carpets
- Outdoor furniture and leisure equipment

Some of the material that you place out for the inorganic collection goes to landfill. Please think of other means of disposing of useful items such as donating reusable items to charities and second-hand shops.

The maximum load allowed is one cubic metre (about two car boots full).

**Remember it is illegal to put your inorganic rubbish on the kerb. This will attract an infringement fee of \$400.**

**Please note: Inorganic rubbish for collection is owned by the person putting the rubbish out. Auckland Council takes ownership of the rubbish at the point of pick up. Items are to be neatly stacked and placed on your private property.**



# Inorganic rubbish collection 2012

## How does it work?

1. You check the schedule and collection terms and conditions online at [www.inorganiccollection.co.nz](http://www.inorganiccollection.co.nz) or contact Auckland Council's customer services inorganic team on (09) 839 0419 to request this information.
2. You book and pay online at [www.inorganiccollection.co.nz](http://www.inorganiccollection.co.nz) by credit card, or by cash/cheque/eftpos at Auckland Council's offices at:
  - 6 Henderson Valley Road
  - Takapuna Service Centre
  - 1 Greys Ave (Auckland CBD) Service Centre
  - Manukau Service Centre
  - Massey Library
  - Whau Local Board Office, New Lynn
  - Waitakere Ranges Local Board Office, Glen Eden

Operating days and hours Monday to Friday, 9.00am-4.00pm.

Note: Collection costs \$23 (including GST). Bookings must be made by midnight Sunday at least three weeks before the start of your collection week.

No late bookings will be permitted. No refunds are available.

3. Once you have booked and paid you will be given a receipt confirming the date on which your inorganic rubbish will be collected.
4. If you have provided an email address with your booking we will send you a reminder in advance of your collection.
5. You place your inorganic rubbish on your property, close to your driveway, before 7am on your collection day. (See 'Placement of your inorganic rubbish' for more details)
6. We collect your inorganic rubbish.

If for any reason we cannot collect your inorganic rubbish on your allocated collection date, we will contact you and arrange an alternate time.

We recommend you are at home on your collection day and ensure that any dogs on your property are restrained.

**Maximum load allowed is one cubic metre (about two car boots full).**

## Placement of your inorganic rubbish

Your inorganic rubbish must be neatly stacked and placed inside your private property for collection. In addition, please ensure:

- The inorganic rubbish is placed at the front of your section, close to the entry point of the property and in a location easily accessible from the driveway and within 10m of truck access
- The inorganic rubbish is placed outside (i.e. not in a garage) and is easily identifiable
- No vehicles or obstructions are left in the driveway and there is clear passage
- Any dogs are tied up away from the collection site
- Gates are unlocked
- The pile must not include any items that are not collected in inorganic collections. (See section below for more information.)

If you do not have an accessible area on your property you will not be able to use this service and should bring your inorganic rubbish to the Waitakere Refuse Transfer Station. Gate rates apply for disposal of some items. Visit our website [www.aucklandcouncil.govt.nz](http://www.aucklandcouncil.govt.nz) or call us to get the details.

## Getting your inorganic collection right

### We don't collect

- ✗ Quantities in excess of a cubic metre
- ✗ Any bagged rubbish or small loose items
- ✗ Garden waste, tree trimmings
- ✗ Gas bottles or cylinders
- ✗ Oil, paint, solvents and chemicals
- ✗ Commercial and farming waste
- ✗ Bricks, broken concrete and rubble, soil or clay
- ✗ Glass, mirrors or crockery
- ✗ Asbestos and fibrolite (refer to Yellow Pages for disposal)
- ✗ Polystyrene or plastic packaging
- ✗ Car parts, bodies, batteries and tyres
- ✗ Building or trade waste
- ✗ Household renovation materials (other than metals)
- ✗ Medical Waste (refer to Yellow Pages for disposal)
- ✗ Recyclable material
- ✗ Anything that cannot be lifted by two people

Except for asbestos, fibrolite and medical waste the above items can be taken to the Waitakere Refuse Transfer Station, 50 The Concourse, Henderson. Gate rates apply for disposal of some items.

Household hazardous waste can be taken to the HazMobile or various refuse transfer stations. Visit [www.hazmobile.govt.nz](http://www.hazmobile.govt.nz) for more information.
