## HEARING DIRECTIONS FROM THE HEARING PANEL - <u>WITNESSES THAT WE DO NOT REQUIRE TO</u> <u>APPEAR AT THE HEARING</u>

- 1. Pursuant to section 34A of the RMA, Auckland Council (the Council) has appointed a Hearing Panel consisting of three independent hearing commissioners -Greg Hill (Chairperson), Mark Farnsworth and Gavin Lister. The Hearing Panel's function is to hear the application and submissions and make a decision on the Plan Change proposal.
- 2. The Hearing Panel has now reviewed the section 42A report, the pre-circulated evidence and correspondence from submitters who are and are not appearing. The Hearing Panel notes that in some cases there are no matters in contention between experts and in other cases those matters have narrowed.
- 3. Given the above, the Hearing Panel has no questions of the Stormwater and Traffic/Transportation witnesses for any of the parties. Accordingly we do not require any of those witnesses to attend the hearing, but suggest that they be available by phone in the event questions emerge in relation to other evidence being presented.
