This is a further submission opposing (in part) two submissions on Private Plan Change 42 Auckland Regional Landfill, Wayby Valley (**Plan Change**) to the Auckland Unitary Plan (operative in Part).

The Transport Agency is a person who has an interest in the proposal that is greater than the interest of the general public. The Transport Agency made a submission on the Plan Change dated 26 May 2020. The submission states that the Transport Agency is neutral regarding the Plan Change, but supports the provisions relating to transportation (I617 Objective 3, I617.4.1, I617.5, and I617.10).

The Transport Agency opposes (in part) the submissions of Skywork Helicopters Limited (submission number 116) and Goatley Holding Limited (submission number 117). Submissions 116 and 117 are identical. The Transport Agency opposes (in part) the entire submissions, both of which raise concerns about effects of additional traffic on the safe and efficient operation of the Goatley Road/Kaipara Flats Road/SH1 intersection. In particular:

- The submissions are broadly concerned that the Precinct Plan (provision number 1617.10) does not appropriately capture traffic effects.
- The submitters request that "appropriate objectives and policies supported by assessment criteria be added to the Precinct provisions to enable the assessment of traffic effects that may arise in the future associated with activities that the Precinct enables such as new landfills and renewable energy for example."
- The submitters consider that the Waste Management proposal will directly negatively impact the safety and efficient operation of the Goatley Road/Kaipara Flats Road/SH1 intersection, and considers that these actual, cumulative and future effects need to be considered.

• The relief sought by the submitters is that Plan Change is approved, but only on the basis that suitable objectives, policies and assessment criteria that address traffic effects on the wider roading network are incorporated.

The reasons for the Transport Agency's opposition (in part) are:

- The Transport Agency's position in its original submission on the Plan Change dated 26 May 2020 remains the same. The Transport Agency supports the provisions in the Plan Change (as lodged) relating to transportation and seeks to understand what provisions the submitters are seeking.
- Given the broad nature of the relief sought in both submissions 116 and 117, it is not entirely clear what changes to the Plan Change provisions the submitters are seeking. As such, the Transport Agency wishes to be involved in any transport issues relating to the Plan Change provisions to ensure that any amendments to the provisions adequately address effects on the transportation network.

The Transport Agency seeks that the submissions be disallowed to the extent that they are inconsistent with the Transport Agency's position on the Plan Change provisions relating to transportation, as outlined in the Transport Agency's original submission.

Referring to the Marshall Day Acoustics findings: 3.0 existing noise environments. They state that readings were not included at receivers 17, 18, 19 or 29 as too close to the road and dominated by road noise. The footnote says the lower the ambient noise level the greater the potential effect when introducing new noise. However they failed to mention that between 10 and 4 am SH1 is currently quiet, dead quiet. This is when residents sleep well and nocturnal species such as longtail bats, Australasian Bittern, morepork, Spotless Crake, call at night utilising the quiet time. If WM operates 24/7 trucks arriving at the bin exchange this will severely impede the booming calls of Bitterns and long tail bats. Also human residents and ratepayers will suffer loss of value and inability to attract buyers because of 24/7 operations bring hundreds of heavy vehicles through the Dome at night, which is currently very quiet at night. Australasian Bitterns and longtail bats are both critically endangered with Bittern numbers only around 900 left! Also the wetlands they inhabit are close to the road in some areas and their booms can be heard at night time by residents now because of breeding season mating calls. This is entirely an inappropriate location for an industrial facility of any kind to

operate 24/7, let alone one of this immense size and nature. Very very bad site selection and must not be a zone change. The zoning is reflective of the current environment. The current residents, flora and fauna belong there, WM does not.

This is a further submission in support of (or in opposition to) a submission on a change proposed to the Auckland Unitary Plan – Proposed Plan Change 42) and for a resource consent. Specifically, with regard to:

- PC65 Private Plan Change 42. We seek to make a further submission against the plan change. We endorse the submission of the Department of Conservation and ask Auckland Council to accept it in full.
- NC101 Notified Resource Consent. We endorse the further submission of the Department of Conservation and ask Auckland Council to accept it in full.

The Tāmaki Makaurau – Auckland Conservation Board (the Board) is an independent statutory body appointed by the Minister for Conservation. It was established by section 6L of the Conservation Act 1987. The Board has a statutory role in advocating its interests in any public forum or in any statutory planning process.

In this regard, the Board would like to make a further submission in relation to the Waste Management NZ (WMNZ) application for a resource consent to construct and operate a new regional Class 1 landfill at Wayby Valley between Wellsford and Warkworth, adjoining Dome Valley and to support the submission of the Department of Conservation with respect to the applicant's request for a change to the Auckland Unitary Plan.

The Director General of Conservation supports the submissions of Treaty partners in relation to the plan change and the resource consent. Our Board endorses this and further notes that the Ngāti Manuhiri Claims Settlement Act 2012 confirms that the Ngāti Manuhiri Area of Interest is inclusive of the Dome Valley area.

We have outlined our views on specific submissions on the table at Appendix 1 in the required format.

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**SERVICED BY** 

In our original submission of 20 May 2020 in opposition to the resource consent application, we asked for "the advice provided to the applicant on other sites which were considered and rejected to understand why this site with its significant ecological values has been selected over others". We would like to reiterate our request for this information, which is pivotal to understanding why the applicant chose this particular site.

Whilst WMNZ is the applicant, we do not consider that it is acceptable for Auckland Council as the unitary authority to re-designate an area with such high biodiversity, mana whenua and water values for such a high-impact, high-risk purpose. There is no detail provided about why existing landfills at Redvale, Whitford or Hampton Downs, which already service the Auckland region, have not been selected.

The Board wishes to be heard in support of our original and this further submission.
