## DIRECTIONS FROM THE HEARING PANEL

## HEARING DATES (FACE-TO-FACE OR MORE LIKELY BY REMOTE ACCESS)

- 1. Pursuant to section 34 and 34A of the RMA, Auckland Council (the Council) has appointed a Hearing Panel consisting of independent hearing commissioners Greg Hill (Chairperson), Mark Farnsworth and Karyn Kurzeja. The Hearing Panel's function is to hear the application and submissions and make a decision on the Plan Change proposal. It is also to address any procedural issues.
- The hearing of this Plan Change was scheduled for the 25 27 August 2021. However, due to Auckland being in 'Covid alert level 4 lock down' the hearing had to be postponed. The hearing for PC 50 has been rescheduled for <u>Monday and Tuesday 29 and 30 November 2021</u>.
- 3. Given the current Covid alert level 3 in Auckland, and that this is likely to remain for some time, the hearing will, if not able to proceed face-to-face, proceed on the dates specified using "remote access facilities" (Teams) pursuant to s39AA(2) of the RMA.
- 4. The Hearing Panel has taken s39AA(4) of the RMA into account in making this Direction. Any party who does not have access to internet will be able to participate via a telephone connection.
- 5. The Council's Senior Hearings Advisor, Mr Sam Otter, will be providing the necessary details for on-line access to the hearing.
- 6. As set out in our 2 September 2021 Direction, we stated:

At the time the hearing was postponed, the evidence exchange had been completed<sup>1</sup> (as set out in our Direction dated 31 March 2021). Accordingly, we are not seeking further evidence from any party. If any party seeks to file additional evidence, a waiver will need to be sought from the Hearing Panel and would need to address the matters set out in section 37 and 37A of the RMA.
