Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki	Will defer to other iwi authorities for ID 00713.
Ngāti Manuhiri	Ngāti Manuhiri advised that they intended to talk to Rangatira discuss this place and report back to Heritage Policy team and were going to discuss with Te Kawerau ā Maki to align a response. Council has not received any further communication to date.
Ngāti Maru	Have a historical interest in these areas but will defer in this case to Ngāti Pāoa and Te Patukirikiri.
Ngāti Pāoa	Will defer to Te Kawerau ā Maki in relation to ID 00713.
Ngāti Tamaterā	Ngāti Tamaterā considered that while physical evidence of this site may be diminished or destroyed, they can work to ensure that the cultural and historical significance of this place is not forgotten. By contributing iwi knowledge, providing oral histories, and potentially collaborating on interpretive signage or educational programming, the legacy of these sites can be preserved in ways that honour Mana Whenua perspectives. Ngāti Tamaterā will have wider discussions (with other iwi) regarding the Mahurangi land block (which this site is within) as it is within our Deed of Settlement area.

Te Kawerau ā Maki	Do not oppose the removal of ID 00713 from Schedule 14.1 in principle. The wider area has value as an ara (walking track) and will be considered for nomination to the Māori Heritage Alert Layer (MHAL)/Māori Cultural Heritage Programme (MCHP).
Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whātua	Supports the position of Te Kawerau ā Maki for places in Upper Harbour. Seek to look at ways to improve information sharing and recognition of values.

Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki	Will defer to other iwi authorities for ID 00720.
Ngāti Manuhiri	Ngāti Manuhiri advised that they intended to talk to Rangatira discuss this place and report back to Heritage Policy team and were going to discuss with Te Kawerau ā Maki to align a response. Council has not received any further communication to date.
Ngāti Maru	Have a historical interest in these areas but will defer in this case to Ngāti Pāoa and Te Patukirikiri.
Ngāti Pāoa	ID 00720 is within an area of significance known as Tauhinu. Do not oppose removal of the place from Schedule 14.1 in principle but will work with Council's Māori Heritage Team on a wider nomination under AUP Schedule 12 or supporting existing nominations to the MCHP.
Ngāti Tamaterā	Ngāti Tamaterā considered that while physical evidence of this site may be diminished or destroyed, they can work to ensure that the cultural and historical significance of this place is not forgotten. By contributing iwi knowledge, providing oral histories, and potentially collaborating on interpretive signage or educational programming, the legacy of these sites can be preserved in ways that honour Mana Whenua perspectives. Support the korero of Te Kawerau ā Maki in relation to this place. Considers this site and the wider area it is within is an area of importance to many iwi.
Ngāti Te Ata	Will defer to other iwi for all four places.
Te Kawerau ā Maki	ID 00720 is within an area of cultural significance associated with Tauhinu (mentioned in Treaty Settlement documentation). Values of the place are linked to views to and across the water and wider landscape associated to nearby pā. Attended site visit for ID 00720, support amendments to retain scheduling over high point / former lookout rather than wider area.
Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whātua	Supports the position of Te Kawerau ā Maki for places in Upper Harbour (ID 00713 and ID 00720). Seek to look at ways to improve information sharing and recognition of values, including consideration of nomination to AUP Schedule 12.

Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki	In relation to ID 00739, they do not oppose the removal of the place from Schedule 14.1 in principle. Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki are considering, in consultation with Ngāti Pāoa, a new nomination of a wider area in the same vicinity to Schedule 12 Sites and Places of Significance to Mana Whenua Schedule (Schedule 12). Council's Māori Heritage Team will meet the relevant iwi to discuss the nomination.
Ngāti Maru	Have a historical interest in these areas but will defer in this case to Ngāti Pāoa and Te Patukirikiri.
Ngāti Pāoa	Do not oppose removal of the place from Schedule 14.1 in principle but will work with Council's Māori Heritage Team on a wider nomination under AUP Schedule 12. Note that the wider Narrow Neck (Te Kiritai) area within which the place is located is already recognised in Schedule 12. ¹
Ngāti Tamaterā	Ngāti Tamaterā considered that while physical evidence of this site may be diminished or destroyed, they can work to ensure that the cultural and historical significance of this place is not forgotten. By contributing iwi knowledge, providing oral histories, and potentially collaborating on interpretive signage or educational programming, the legacy of these sites can be preserved in ways that honour Mana Whenua perspectives. The Narrow Neck (Te Kiritai) area is of importance to the Marutūahu confederation of iwi. Will be happy to support the work of Ngāti Pāoa regarding the recognition of Te Kiritai through the Māori Cultural Heritage Programme.
