Subject: Schedule 1, clause 8D – Partial withdrawal of Proposed Plan Change 102: Sites

and Places of Significance to Mana Whenua Tranche 2a (Proposed Plan Change

102) to the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) 2016.

(1) The withdrawal of a proposed plan change, or part of a proposed plan change,

requires decision making pursuant to clause 8D of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (**RMA**). The decision to withdraw a Council initiated plan change, in whole or in part, can be made by a Council officer at Tier 4 through the delegated authority in Schedule 2A (p.106) of *Auckland Council Chief Executive*'s

Delegation Register (October 2024, Version 1.7).

In doing so, a local authority is required to give public notice of the withdrawal and reasons for doing so. Proposed Plan Change 102 has not yet proceeded to a Council hearing, so the Council has the ability to withdraw the plan change in whole or in part. The withdrawal Reason for withdrawal: 1. The nominating mana whenua entity, Ngāti Whātua Ōrākei, has requested that Site 114 – Te Rae o Kāwharu and Site 115 - Waipapa Awa be withdrawn from Proposed Plan Change 102. Changes required to be made Pursuant to clause 8D of Schedule 1 of the RMA, withdraw reference to Site 114 - Te Rae o Kāwharu and Site 115 -Waipapa Awa in Proposed Plan Change 102 and replace with the term 'withdrawn' in Chapter L: Schedule 12 - Sites and Places of Significance to Mana Whenua Schedule.

Remove the proposed Sites and Places of Significance to Mana Whenua Overlay from **Site 114 – Te Rae o Kāwharu and Site 115 – Waipapa Awa** in the Auckland Unitary Plan maps.

The relevant line items and planning maps are shown marked as attached.

The Council will give public notice of the partial withdrawal of Proposed Plan Change 102, and the supporting reason, on 7 February 2025.

I am delegated to make decisions under Schedule 1 of the RMA (excluding clause 17). I have made the decision, under delegated authority, to withdraw Plan Change 102 in part, to remove Site 114 – Te Rae o Kāwharu and Site 115 – Waipapa Awa from Proposed Plan Change 102 and to make the stated consequential changes needed to the Auckland Unitary Plan maps, for the reason set out above.




