

At its meeting on 4 February 2021 the council resolved to approve the above plan change to the Auckland Unitary Plan following the completion of the statutory processes.








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Sites and Places of Significance to Mana Whenua Tauhinu Pa



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Sites and Places of Significance to Mana Whenua - Motungaengae








Sites and Places of Significance to Mana Whenua Te Kōpua a Matakamokamo








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






Sites and Places of Significance to Mana Whenua Te Toka Tapu a Kupe


