Proposed Plan Change 78 - additional opportunity to lodge a further submission

- any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest; and
- any person that has an interest in the plan greater than the interest that the general public has; and
- the local authority itself (Auckland Council)

A further submission must be lodged:

- using the prescribed form (see below for more information)
- with Auckland Council by **30/01/2023** when the period for making further submissions closes
- with the original submitter not later than 5 working days after lodging the further submission with Auckland Council.
