

## Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part)

### Plan Change 82 - additional opportunity to lodge a further submission

We are re-notifying four (4) submission points because although submitters requested changes to Plan Change 78 the decisions requested relate to Plan Change 82.

Allocating these points to Plan Change 82 allows a fairer process. A separate further submissions process is available for these submission points only.

The summary of decisions requested relate to the removal of the Historic Heritage Overlay Extent of Place from a range of topics including but not limited to:

- 187 and 191 Gillies Avenue, Epsom
- 2 Princes Street, Auckland Central
- 331 – 335A Great North Road, Grey Lynn

The following persons may make a further submission:

- any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest; and
- any person that has an interest in the plan greater than the interest that the general public has; and
- the local authority itself (Auckland Council)

A further submission must be lodged:

- using the prescribed form (see below for more information)
- with Auckland Council by **2/03/2023** when the period for making further submissions closes
- with the original submitter not later than 5 working days after lodging the further submission with Auckland Council.
