



## 1. Submitter Details

#### 2. Introduction

Archaeological sites listed in Schedule 14.1 Historic Heritage as places of interest or significance to Māori provide an essential record of cultural values that exist within these places. These archaeological records can sometimes be the only indicator that tangible and/or intangible cultural values exist to protect sites and places from inappropriate subdivision, use and development.

Schedule 14.1 recognises and provides for the following matters of national importance in section 6 of the RMA:

- (e) The relationship of Maori and their culture and traditions with their ancestral lands, water, sites, waahi tapu, and other taonga:
- (f) The protection of historic heritage from inappropriate subdivision, use, and development:

The AUP recognises that there may be an overlap between the Historic Heritage Overlay and the Sites and Places of Significance to Mana Whenua Overlay, where both sets of provisions may apply (D17.1 Background):

Places of Māori interest or significance

Scheduled historic heritage places and places identified as having significance or value to Mana Whenua may overlap. In these instances the provisions in <u>D21 Sites and Places</u> of <u>Significance to Mana Whenua Overlay</u> also apply, in addition to any other overlay that may apply to the scheduled historic heritage place.

## 3. Places of Māori interest or significance

## Submission

Te Ākitai Waiohua is concerned that the removal of archaeological sites of Māori interest or significance will leave a gap in the protection of tangible and intangible cultural values where they have not yet been included in Schedule 12 Sites and Places of Significance to Mana Whenua Overlay.

The Section 32 Report identifies that consultation with mana whenua confirmed the sites proposed to be removed from Schedule 14.1 have been nominated for inclusion in Schedule 12. Unfortunately, the process of investigating nominated sites for inclusion in Schedule 12 takes a long time and these sites remain unprotected until a plan change is notified.

Te Ākitai Waiohua acknowledges that the Māori Heritage Alert Layer provides an alternative method for identifying cultural values of these sites where they have not been included in Schedule 12. It is essential that before any sites are removed from Schedule 14.1, they are confirmed as being identified within the Māori Heritage Alert Layer. It is unclear whether this has occurred for the sites in question.

Te Ākitai Waiohua neither supports nor opposes PC116 but seeks that the Auckland Council urgently progress the Sites and Places of Significance work to protect the tangible and intangible Mana Whenua values.

Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga (HNZPT) is an autonomous Crown Entity with statutory responsibility under the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga Act 2014 (HNZPTA) for the identification, protection, preservation, and conservation of New Zealand's historical and cultural heritage. HNZPT is New Zealand's lead agency for heritage protection.

  - ID 00800 Midden R11\_970, 31A Norwood Road, Bayswater

#### 6. HNZPT's submission is:

- 6.1. HNZPT was directly notified about the plan change and was involved in pre-consultation with Auckland Council prior to notification. HNZPT reviewed the proposed changes to Schedule 14.1 and advised Council that the amendments were valid (June 2025).
- 6.2. HNZPT has reviewed Proposed Plan Change 14 and confirms this aligns with the preconsultation held with Auckland Council.




