

Auckland Unitary Plan

Summary of decisions requested on proposed plan change is now available, and invitation to lodge further submissions – Proposed Plan Change 20 : Rural Activity Status in the Auckland Unitary Plan Operative in part

The Summary of Decisions Requested in submissions on Proposed Plan Change 20 : Rural Activity Status (**proposal**) is now available and further submissions, in the prescribed form, can now be lodged as provided for in Clauses 7 and 8 of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991.

A copy of the Summary of Decisions Requested, and a copy of the submissions, can be inspected at any Library or Council office or viewed or downloaded online at www.aucklandcouncil.govt.nz/unitaryplanmodifications.

The following persons may make a further submission, in the prescribed form:

- any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest; and
- any person that has an interest in the proposal greater than the interest that the general public has;
- the local authority itself (Auckland Council)

A further submission may only express support or opposition to a matter raised in an original submission (made under clauses 6 or 6A). It must not raise new points of submission. It must follow the format set out in the RMA (Form 6). Forms are on our website.

Further submissions must be lodged using the prescribed form (Form 6), which can be completed online or downloaded from the Auckland Council website at www.aucklandcouncil.govt.nz/unitaryplanmodifications or collected from any Library or Council office. Any hardcopy forms must be posted to: Auckland Council, Private Bag 92300, Auckland 1142, with a copy also required to be sent to the original submitter not later than 5 working days after lodging the 'further submission' with the Auckland Council (Clause 8A, Schedule 1).

Further submissions must be lodged by no later than **4 July 2019**.

Following the close of further submissions, a report will be prepared on the proposal and a hearing date will be set and notified to all submitters and 'further submitters' who wish to be heard.
