A further submission may only express support or opposition to a matter raised in an original submission (made under clauses 6 or 6A (RMA1991).). It must not raise new points of submission and it must follow the format set out in the Form 6 online as below.

Further submissions must be lodged using the prescribed form (Form 6), which can be completed online or downloaded from the Auckland Council website at www.aucklandcouncil.govt.nz/unitaryplanmodifications

or online from any Library or Council office.

with a copy also required to be sent to the original submitter not later than 5 working days after lodging the further submission with the Auckland Council (Clause 8A, Schedule 1 RMA 1991).

Further submissions must be lodged by **13 June 2019**

Following the close of further submissions, a report will be prepared on the proposal and a hearing date will be set and notified to all submitters and 'further submitters' who wish to be heard.
