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








# **Operative AUP**

Map H8.11.3 City Centre Zone General building height







# **Decision process**

- Process set out in clause 101 of Schedule 1 of the RMA
- The council is required to make decisions on the IHP recommendations
- The council must decide whether to accept or reject each recommendations of the IHP
- Auckland Council's decisions must be notified by 30 May 2025 (Minister's direction)
- Public notification of accepted recommendations will include date when provisions will be operative

# **IHP City Centre recommendations**

  - recommendation and the Council's alternative recommendation and make a decision.









# Karangahape Road Precinct extent

Karangahape road




Notified precinct extent (Notified Chapter I206)

# Viaduct Harbour Precinct – recommended height increases on specific sites





Comparison of heights proposed within the Viaduct Harbour Precinct:
