Notice of Requirement for designation for an upgrade of Trig Road North, Whenuapai, to an urban arterial corridor. This includes the upgrade of the existing Brigham Creek and Spedding Road intersections, and tie ins with Northside Drive and State Highway 18 on ramps.

Notice of Requirement (NOR W1 – Trig Road (North)

Auckland Council has received a notice of a requirement for a designation from Auckland Transport as the Requiring Authority, for public work.

The requirement is for the construction, operation and maintenance of a transport corridor at Trig Road, north of State Highway 18, to enable the Requiring Authority to:

- Provide an urban arterial transport corridor between State Highway 18 and Brigham Creek Road to support and integrate with the planned urban residential growth of Whenuapai.
- Provide arterial transport corridors that are safe for all transport users.
- Contribute to mode shift by providing a choice of transport options including walking, cycling and public transport.

The site to which the requirement applies is as follows: Trig Road between State Highway 18 and Brigham Creek Road.

Making a submission on the notice of requirement

Any person or organisation may make a submission on the notice of requirement, but a person who is a trade competitor or the requiring authority may do so only if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the requirement relates that –

- (a) Adversely affects the environment; and
- (b) Does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
