

Roulston Park | Concept Plan



Design Elements;

- 01 Hoggin 4 m wide driveway into cottage, with brick edging.
- 02 Existing historic fence at entrance of property to remain.
- 03 Existing historic drinking fountain, surrounds to be paved with brick and concrete .
- 04 Existing Camellia tree, with proposed small garden and brick edging to surround it.
- 05 Proposed brick and concrete paved plaza.
- 06 Proposed new storage and artifact display building.
- 07 Existing Pioneer Cottage, with new hoggin pathway and additional planting.
- 08 Proposed hoggin 1.8 m wide pathway loop around park, weaving through existing trees.
- 09 Existing time capsule rock to remain.
- 10 Rose beds extended to meet pathway, brick edging, and re-planted.
- 11 Existing war memorial concrete plinths to be plastered, draping plants planted behind, and surrounding surface paved to meet intersection and existing footpaths. Pram ramp and tactile indicators included.
- 12 Proposed bus pull in space, cut into existing road reserve. Enough car parking space for 5 vehicles also. Kassell kerb for bus pull in ease, and footpath to be re-paved in this area.
- 13 Existing toilet building to remain.
- 14 Proposed new playground.
- 15 Brick and concrete paved area. Percussion play equipment to be placed here, and existing Rhododendron tree included at centre.
- 16 Some percussion play equipment placed within trees.
- 17 New picnic tables.
- 18 New park bench seats.
- 19 Proposed shrub planting.
