## LEGEND

- Replace existing hardstand to the left hand side of the Foch Ave entrance with planting. 1
- Proposed tree/hedge planting along fenceline to provide visual screening to neighbouring 2 properties along south-west and south-eastern boundaries.
- Remove existing tennis courts and return area to lawn B
- 4 Renew bounce wall in conjunction with tennis court upgrade
- 5 Addition of 4 proposed cycle racks and drinking fountain outside Tennis Club building.
- Upon footpath renewal, realign and straighten existing footpath from Foch Ave entry to 6 Tennis Club.
- Existing children's playground (note: equipment shown is indicative only). 7
  - a. inclusion of ramp off footpath to improve access into playspace
  - b. investigate the inclusion of additional playground items into existing playspace i.e. marble runs
  - c. investigate the removal of existing keyboard play equipment
  - d. investigate the feasibility of shifting the tall climbing module away from the fenceline towards the tennis court, place low equipment beside fence.
  - e. when playground is up for renewal ensure tall equipment is located away from boundary
- When playground equipment is relocated or renewed (refer note 7) plant boundary with 8 trees, and shrubs to provide visual screening for neighbouring properties.
- Court hardstand to be reduced in width by 3m to accommodate a 1.8m wide exposed 9 aggregate concrete path running through the reserve from Hazel Ave to the carpark off Foch Ave. Existing lights along fenceline and within hardstand to be removed.
- Relocate tennis court boundary fencing to accommodate proposed concrete path and add 10 extra gated court entrance.
- Upgraded tennis courts to have moveable nets to accommodate a wider range of multi 11 sport activities, i.e. netball, basketball and volleyball and informal activities including Tai Chi, boot camp, learn-to-ride and informal play.
- 12 Existing tree to be relocated to accommodate path through reserve.
- 13 Investigate provision off all abilities ramped access to VHF club with access located adjacent to mobility carpark and loading bay.
- Proposed 11 space Hazel Ave carpark, including 1 mobility carpark. High kerb to carpark 14 edge to deter vehicles from driving onto adjacent lawn area. Inclusion of lockable gate at carpark entrance.
- Carpark to include 1 mobility carpark and loading zone with kerb ramp to adjacent footpath to assist with transferring equipment between truck and building.
- Remove invasive bamboo along site boundary and replace with native screen planting. 16
- Relocate existing table tennis table to accommodate proposed carpark. 17
- Proposed bollards at 1.5m centres along Hazel Ave boundary to restrict vehicle access to the grass area.
- 19 Proposed specimen trees.
- Investigate adding dotted yellow lines near the driveway entrance on Hazel Ave to improve 20 access into reserve (Auckland Transport involvement required).
- Proposed footpath along Hazel Ave to connect up to park path. Consultation with arborist required as path located within the rootplate of the Fig tree (Auckland Transport involvement required).
- Remove reference to 'Mt Roskill Scouts' from the park sign on Hazel Ave. Upon renewal 22 relocate the new sign closer to the road.
- 23 Maintain open lawn area for informal sports.

## LONG TERM OPTION



This is an aspirational / long term plan. It proposes the relocation of the children's playground from its current location (note: the playground equipment and layouts shown above are indicative only). It includes the integration of a learn-to-ride bike track into the playspace to counteract the loss of this activity with the two central court becoming a tennis and multi sports facility

This layout reduces the pinch point between the current playground and tennis courts, opens up sightlines into the park from Hazel Ave and provides a continuous green link from the front to the back of the reserve.
