SISTER CITY AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE CITY OF AUCKLAND OF NEW ZEALAND

AND

THE PUSAN METROPOLITAN CITY OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA

The City of Auckland of New Zealand and the Pusan Metropolitan City of the Republic of Korea, proceeding from the common desire to further promote and enhance the mutual understanding and the existing friendship between the people of New Zealand and the people of the Republic of Korea, have decided to establish a sister city relationship between the two Cities.

The Hon. Les Mills, Mayor of Auckland City, and the Hon. Moon Jung-Soo, Mayor of Pusan Metropolitan City agree, in accordance with the principles of equality and mutual benefit, to encourage co-operation in various fields such as trade, the environment and technology, culture and arts, sports, fisheries, tourism and municipal administration with a view to promoting the prosperity and goodwill of both Cities, and together contributing to the development of close, friendly and co-operative relations between the New Zealand and Korean people.
