

Small-scale land disturbance and intrusive investigation notification form

Some activities, such as small-scale disturbance and intrusive investigations require prior notification to Auckland Council to meet the Permitted Activity (PA) standard. Relevant details can be provided on this form.

The relevant PA standards for discharges arising from activities on contaminated land (or potentially contaminated land) can be found in the Auckland Unitary Plan: Operative in Part (AUP(OP)), <u>Chapter E30.6.1</u>.

Please note: Common circumstances where small-scale land disturbance of a contaminated land site does not meet PA standards include:

- A volume of soil disturbance which exceeds 200m³ per site
- Disturbance of land containing separate phase liquid contaminants, including separate phase hydrocarbons
- A duration of soil disturbance which exceeds two months

Contaminated material removed from the site must be disposed of at a facility or site authorised to accept such material.
