Tamaki Pathway Stage 2

Thank you for your information request dated 30 March 2026, regarding Tamaki Pathway Stage 2.

Funding context

The Tāmaki Path Stage 2 project was approved and funded under the Tāmaki Infrastructure Funding Framework Agreement (IFFA), a local governance and funding arrangement between Auckland Council, Auckland Transport and Tāmaki Redevelopment Company. Funding was considered through Auckland Council's decision-making and IFFA governance processes, not through a central-government funding programme.

The specific details of your request and our response is below.

- 1. ask for the Business case submitted for funding - please provide me with this. So that I can publish it. My view is it was written by the AC Parks Dept, or on it's behalf. I am asking Kainga Ora for it too.**

Auckland Council holds the following business case documents prepared to support internal approval and IFFA funding decisions:

- **Document A** - Business Case - Tāmaki Estuary Greenway (Signed)
- **Document B** - Business Case Summary - Tāmaki Path Stage 2 (21 March 2022)

These documents were considered as part of the Project Steering Group approval process, as recorded in **Document C** - PSG Agenda (25 March 2021).

Auckland Council does not hold a business case submitted to central government, the Minister of Housing, Kāinga Ora or the Infrastructure Acceleration Fund in relation to this project. Accordingly, this part of your request is refused under section 17(e) of the Local Government Official Information And Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA), as the information requested does not exist.

2. all infrastructure funding is regulated "funding grants set out what the funding can be used for, and they include reporting and assurance requirements so the Government can be confident money is spent for the agreed purpose". "the IAF supports infrastructure that enables housing growth, including local transport improvements". Please provide the required reports so that I can publish these.

The reporting and assurance records held by Auckland Council for this project are:

- **Document D** - PWG Meeting Summary - Approval for Tāmaki IFA Funded Projects (4 March 2022)
- **Document E** - PSG Meeting Summary - Tāmaki IFA Funded Projects (25 March 2022)

These documents constitute the reporting, assurance and approval records required under the Tāmaki Infrastructure Funding Framework Agreement and Auckland Council governance processes.

Auckland Council does not hold reports prepared to meet central-government infrastructure grant or IAF reporting requirements for this project, as no such funding framework applied. This part of your request is refused under section 17(e) of the LGOIMA.

Decisions regarding the information being released to you were made by Taryn Crewe, General Manager Parks and Community Facilities.

Should you believe Auckland Council has not responded appropriately to your request you have the right to seek a review of the decision from the Ombudsman.
