

FERGUSSON DOMAIN CONCEPT PLAN



- 1 Gathering and rest area.
- 2 Hard courts upgraded with a new gated entrance from the basketball court.
- 3 Reconfigure the building into a public toilet with external access and storage for sports gear.
- 4 Expand the playground area to include seats, picnic tables under a shelter or fale, a drinking fountain, and a learn-to-ride path.
- 5 Refurbish Oranga Community Centre to create a new venue for hire, with capacity for over 100 people.
- 6 Mark a drop-off bay outside the community centre.
- 7 Improve the garden area with tidied vegetation and landscaping upgrades.
- 8 Remove the Hull Place walkway.
- 9 Mark a 1km loop with 100m increments on the existing path network.
- 10 Picnic and BBQ area for gatherings, with open flat space available as a multi-use zone.
- 11 Develop a walking track or nature play area within the forest. Improve the ecosystem and carry out tree crown lifting.
- 12 Provide vehicle access into the car park next to the sports club.
- 13 Install a disc golf course.
- 14 Establish a community garden space.
- 15 Build a small bike track within the forest area. Improve the ecosystem and lift tree crowns.
- 16 Install removable bollards to allow closure of the internal park road.
- 17 Remove Fergusson Hall. Create a youth play item and provide additional picnic and gathering space.
- 18 Extension of carpark.
