Item 1 – Large map of Auckland:

The images below are two regional maps (one with ward boundaries and one with local board boundaries) The resolution is not the best at the regional scale – given the need to fit so much in, but the important thing is that these two maps act as a key to the maps in Item 2 below. This link contains high resolution PDFs for each ward that can be printed that have all of the key roads so that boundaries can be assessed.


Item 3 – Busy roads:
