The Landing Car Park - Parking Information

Hours of Operation

Parking is available **24 hours a day, 7 days a week**, with fees applying at all times.

Parking Fees

- Up to 15-min max, **Free**, no licence plate entry required.
- *Up to 90-minutes max **Free**, Licence plate entry required
- If you will be staying beyond the 90-minutes free time, then you must pre-pay at the following rates:
 - Vehicles: **\$3.00 per hour**
 - Car and trailer: **\$5.00 per hour**
 - Maximum daily rate: **\$22.00** (allows multiple entries and exits)

* Free Parking

Each vehicle is granted 90 minutes of free parking per day.

To claim this, you must enter your licence plate number on arrival into the car park using:

- Any parking machine in the carpark
- The ParKiwi Parking App - downloadable from Apple or Google
- The onsite Scan2Pay QR code

Please note:

- The 90 minutes free parking is limited to one allocation per vehicle, per day.
- The free parking session is applied only to the vehicles first parking session of the day and cannot be split across multiple visits.

How to pay for your parking

Payment options include:

- Pay-by-Plate Parking Machines
- ParKiwi App
- Scan2Pay QR code

Payment methods include credit/debit card, Google Pay and Apple Pay.

Upon entry into the car park, select your parking duration. If you stay longer than expected, your active parking session can be extended.

If your parking session has expired, you can pay for your time used by starting another parking session before you leave.

If you're unsure how long you'll stay, we recommend using the ParKiwi Parking App, which allows you to start and stop your parking session, so you only pay for the time you use.

Accessible Parking

Accessible car parks are available – refer to the onsite map for locations. Please ensure you display a valid mobility parking permit.

Parking fees apply to accessible parking.

Breach Notices and Appeals

Cameras record the entry and exit times of vehicles. All vehicles that enter the car park agree to the signposted terms and conditions.

If you are in breach of these terms and conditions, you may be issued a breach notice fee of \$75.

If you receive a breach notice and wish to appeal it, please contact Stellar, the parking management company.
