### **Notice of Requirement for a designation for Kumeū Secondary School – Educational Purposes – School (Years 0 – 13)**

#### **Notice of Requirement**

Auckland Council has received a notice of a requirement for a designation from the Minister of Education as the Requiring Authority, for public work.

The requirement will enable the Requiring Authority to develop a new secondary school catering for school age children from Year 9 to Year 13 and to enable the opportunity for shared facilities including but not limited to parking, access, and drop off/pick up with the adjacent Year 0-8 Huapai District School. The new designation will partly overlap the existing Huapai District School designation where existing access and parking is located.

The site to which the requirement applies is as follows: 40 Station Road, 54 Station Road, 60 Station Road and 43 Trigg Road, Huapai.

#### **Making a submission on the notice of requirement**

Any person or organisation may make a submission on the notice of requirement, but a person who is a trade competitor of the requiring authority may do so only if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the requirement relates that –

- (a) Adversely affects the environment; and
- (b) Does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
