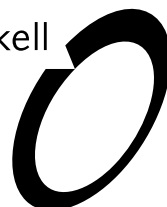

RE: RESPONSE TO SECOND INFORMATION REQUEST UNDER CLAUSE 23(2) RMA ON A PRIVATE PLAN CHANGE REQUEST TO THE AUCKLAND UNITARY PLAN - FRANKLIN 2 PRECINCT
