Subject: Dual Plan Modification: Clause 16 amendment to a proposed plan change: Plan Change 78

Intensification and 20A error correction to Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part 2016)

I seek your approval to make an amendment to or correct an error in a proposed plan change provision and to correct an error in the equivalent provision in the AUP.

Clause 16(2)¹ provides that:

A local authority may make an amendment, without using the process in this schedule, to its proposed policy statement or plan to alter any information, where such an alteration is of minor effect, or may correct any minor errors.

The RMA defines *proposed plan* at section 43AAC as follows:

- (1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, proposed plan—
 - (a) means a proposed plan, a variation to a proposed plan or change, or a change to a plan proposed by a local authority that has been notified under clause 5 of Schedule 1 or given limited notification under clause 5A of that schedule, but has not become operative in terms of clause 20 of that schedule; and
 - (b) includes—
 - (i) a proposed plan or a change to a plan proposed by a person under Part 2 of Schedule 1 that has been adopted by the local authority under clause 25(2)(a) of Schedule 1:
 - (ii) an IPI notified in accordance with section 80F(1) or (2).

Plan Change 78 is a council-initiated plan change to the Auckland Unitary Plan that has been notified but has not yet been approved under clause 17, Schedule 1, or become operative.

I also seek your approval to correct an error pursuant to clause 20A²

A local authority may amend, without using the process in this schedule, an operative policy statement or plan to correct any minor errors.

You have delegated authority, as a tier four manager, to make a decision to correct an error under clause 20A. Schedule 2A of the Auckland Council Combined Chief Executives Delegation Register authorises all powers, functions, and duties under RMA's first schedule (except clause 17 which cannot be delegated) to tier four positions.

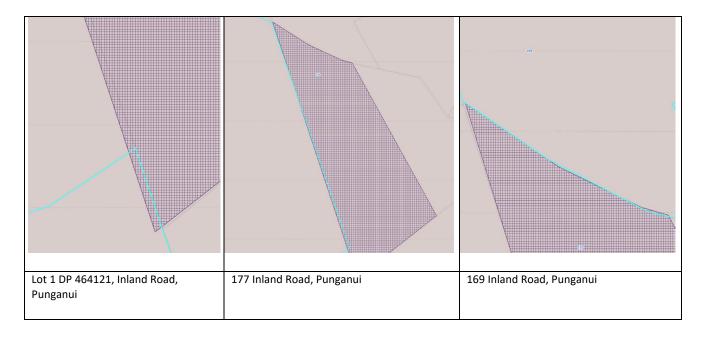

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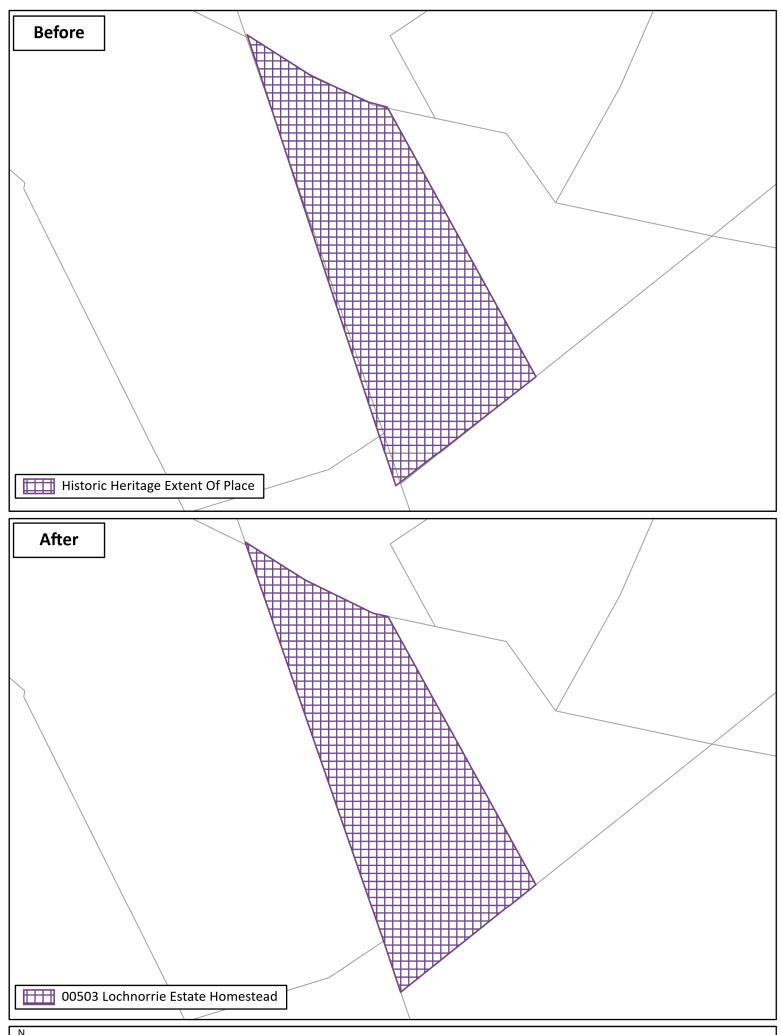


Attachment 1: A sliver of the EOP for ID 00503 that extends onto three adjoining properties on Inland Road

Subject: Correction to the Record of Auckland Unitary Plan modifications 2025

The clause 16 delegated approval, dated 31 January 2025, to correct the extent of place errors for Lochnorrie Estate Homestead (Schedule 14.1 ID 00503) in the proposed plan change: Plan Change 78 Intensification (PC78) (see Attachment 1) has been **withdrawn**.

The place, located at 173 Inland Road, Punganui (PT ALLOT NE27 PSH OF ARARIMU SO 37), is not within the urban environment and is therefore not subject to PC78. This means no clause 16 was required.

The clause 20A delegated approval to correct the extent of place for this place within the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part 2016) remains.

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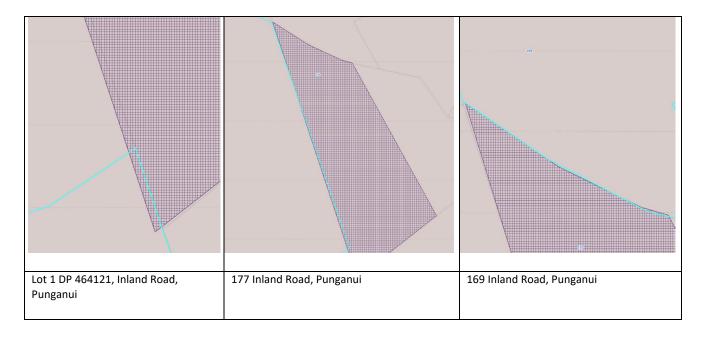

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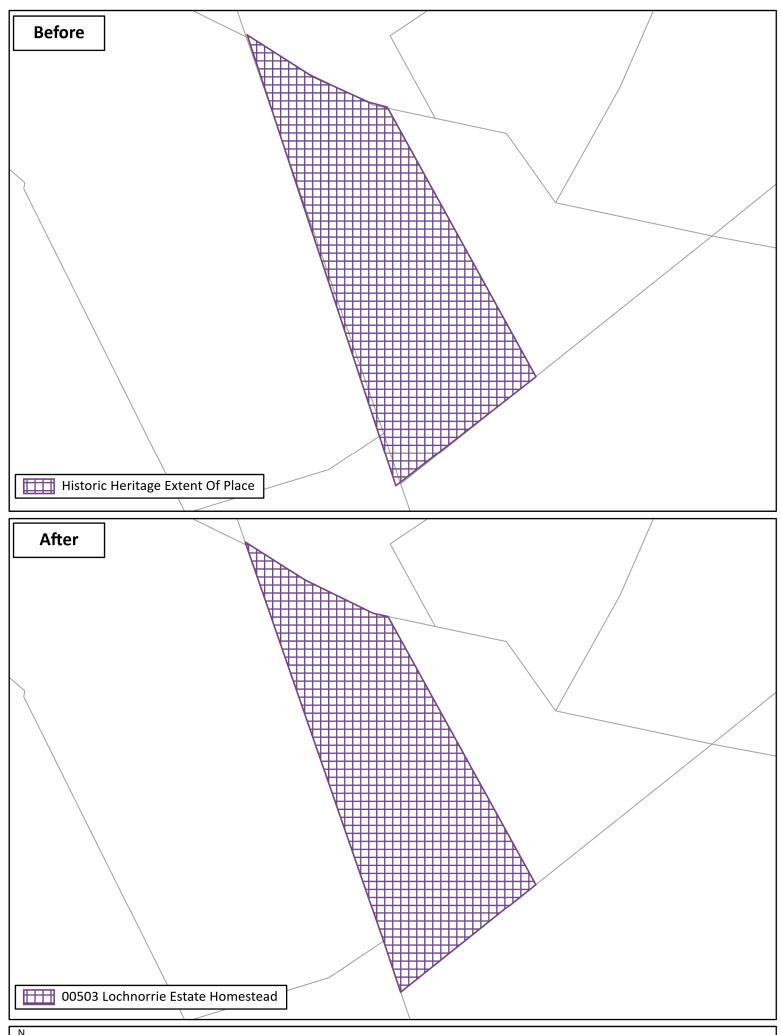
