

Creative Community Scheme Auckland Funded Projects 2021/2022

In 2021-2022, Auckland Creative Communities Scheme assessment committees granted \$1,111,549 to support 259 local projects.

The Creative Communities Scheme has created opportunities for 47,964 people of all ages to actively participate in local arts activities, with a projected audience of 457,297 people. The scheme enables communities to bring art into the everyday lives of Aucklanders across the region on beaches, in parks, on marae, in community halls, theatres, streets and galleries with music, dance, film-making, weaving, whakairo, sculpting, singing, poetry, theatre – a wide range creative cultural expression in many art forms within our community. capable of becoming the ‘cornerstones’ of a thriving arts and culture sector in Auckland.
