MR C LEVIN (SUBMITTER 504) - CODING OF THE SUBMISSION TO BOTH PLAN CHANGES 78 AND 82.

- 1. In accordance with the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA) Part 6 Clause 96 of the First Schedule and sections 34 and 34A, the Auckland Council (the Council) has appointed an Independent Hearing Panel (IHP). The IHP has been delegated to hear submissions and make recommendations to the Council on the IPI plan changes and decisions on the non IPI plan changes. Its delegations also include addressing any procedural matters.
- 2. The IHP has received the Memorandum¹ from Mr Webb, legal counsel for Mr Levin in respect of the coding of the submission to both Plan Changes 78 and 82. Paragraph 8 of the Memorandum states:

The allocation to PC 82 was at the direction of the Council. Without prejudice to the position of any further submitters, Mr Levin requests submissions 28.1 and 28.2 be reallocated back to PC78 as 504.1 and 504.2

- 3. The IHP records that Mr Levin's entire submission can be heard when they speak to the other relevant submission point at the hearings for PC 78. This will, as pointed out by Mr Webb "..have the additional advantage of enabling all submissions originally filed as 504 to be heard together as they are complementary to each other"².
