

Have your say on the Elliot Street to Pescara Point Bridge – Shared Pathway

Feedback opens Friday 15 March 2019 and closes Friday 12 April 2019.

Auckland Council, on behalf of the Papakura Local Board, is currently investigating a proposed shared pathway connection from Elliot Street to Pescara Point. This comprises two of the greenway connections to promote walking and cycling opportunities, known as sections 12 and 13, Elliot to Freelance Terrace and Freelance Terrace to Pescara Point. This is your opportunity to have your say on the proposed project.

We are at the early stages of the project and need your feedback to help us understand the opportunities and impacts these pathways would have on the area.
