Any other action is wholly irresponsible, and betrays the council's responsibility to Aucklanders now and in the future who will pay a far heavier cost from climate change impacts, than even a 10% rise in rates now.

The council also has a moral obligation to implement all the planned road safety improvements. Cutting them as proposed in the budget will result in 10 more road deaths per year.
