The Parnell Plan will be a Waitemātā Local Board sponsored strategic document that sets out the community's 30-year vision for the area as well as ways that vision can be achieved.

- Support community collaboration, initiatives and events for our diverse communities

Objective 4: Care for, protect and enhance our natural environment

- Enhance and restore our streams, waterways and bays
- Enhance biodiversity through predator control and by planting appropriate vegetation, in particular, native vegetation
- Encourage greater collaboration between local government, mana whenua, land owners and the community to protect and restore our natural environment
