Devonport-Takapuna Local Board has resolved to upgrade the old toilets and changing rooms to provide for the increasing activity in the area and demand on these facilities. QUESTIONS

The proposed design uses a circular 'tree-trunk' shaped plan, referencing the trees of ancient forests once stood here. Lava flows from Pupuke volcano buried parts of these forests, fossilising and casting moulds of trees in the event. Likewise, the building is partially buried, and it is hoped that together with the combination of basalt stone and timber materials, this will connect the new structure to the landscape and provide some timeless qualities and a sense of permanence. The facilities will be easily accessed and easily visible from the southern end of the park including the playground area while the removal of the current ablution block will free up space near the beach for public activities.

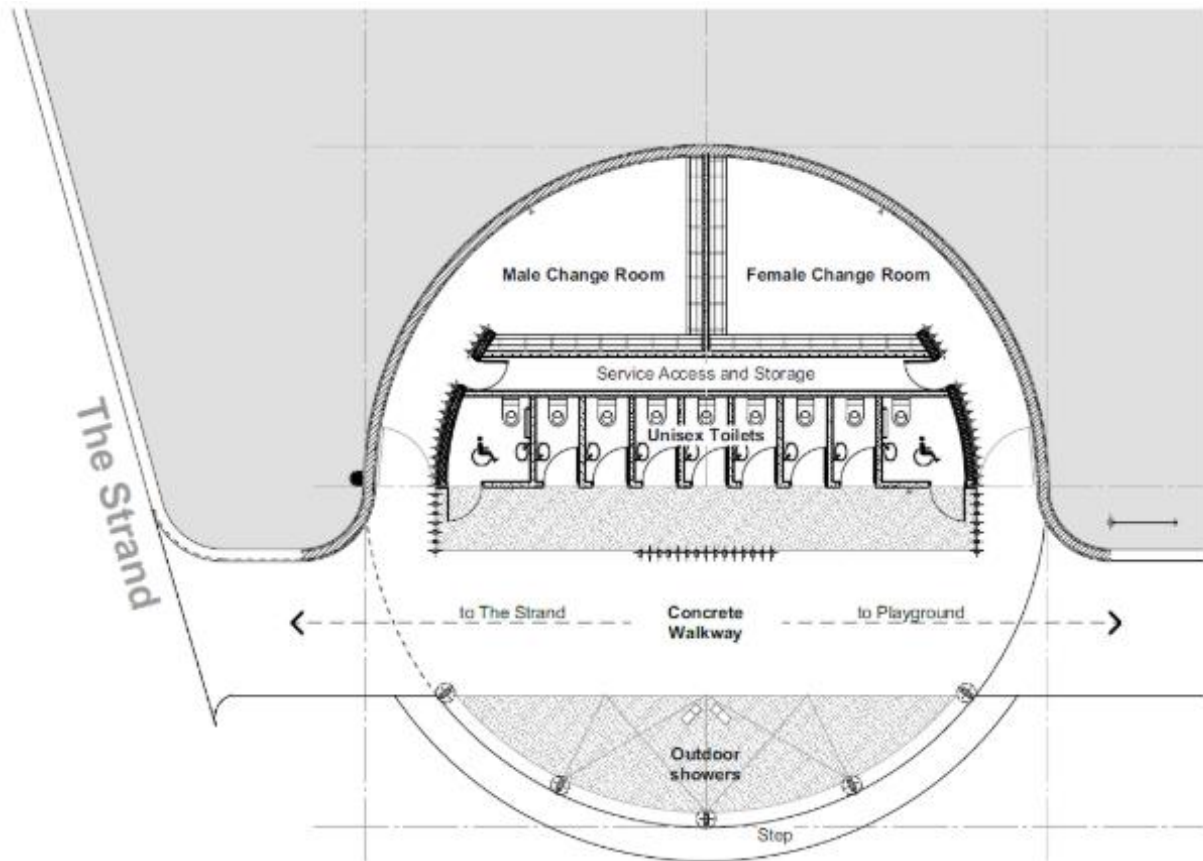
