



Have your say on the proposed Redevelopment of the Churchill Park Lookout

Churchill Park is one of Auckland’s premier parks. It sits on the ridge above Karaka Bay in Ōrākei and has a rural character.

Previous to being purchased by Auckland Council, the site was a privately-owned golf club, with the club house located at the lookout site. The club house remained for many years, following development as a park, but was removed recently. Since then the site has been vacant, and Auckland Council is now exploring options of how best to develop the space in order to make it usable, enjoyable and accessible for the public.

Previous to the site being a golf club, a layered history of both Maori and European occupation precedes it. The lookout site specifically is important because it provides 360° views of its surrounds and looks out to many landmarks. The design of the site aims to respond to these magnificent views, enhancing appreciation and meaning where possible.
