

Waikowhai Park Accessible Map

Accessible Information

Waikowhai Park presents challenges, with steep gravel bush tracks and stairs heading down the valley. The playground has steep banks, steps and bark surfacing. There are no accessible car parks, though an accessible toilet is available within the upper carpark and both the lookout and dog walking area can be reached via navigable paths.

This map indicates which facilities and amenities are accessible. All park features on the map which are orange in the key are accessible. The Puketāpapa Local Board are working towards improving accessibility in this park.
