Accessible Information

The shared path is flat and provides access to all features within both parks, including seating and picnic tables. Several smaller paths weave across the stream. An accessible toilet is located in Walmsley Park adjacent to the Fale. There are no on-site carparks. The surface of the playground is bark and it is not fenced.






This map indicates which facilities and amenities are accessible. All park features on the map which are orange in the key are accessible. The Puketāpapa Local Board are working towards improving accessibility in this park.



