## Self-Containment Certificate (SCC) Pass

The SCC Pass must be obtained through the Auckland Council Contact Centre and paid in full. Please note:

- The actual pass will be mailed out – OR - if **prior arrangements are made** the pass can be picked up from:
  - Bledisloe Lane, CBD Service Centre, 24 Wellesley Street, Auckland Central – Regional Parks Team.
- The pass **cannot be used** to book in advance, customers are advised to call before leaving for the park to check availability for use.

**The Self-Containment Certificate (SCC) Pass is not valid** during December, January and February (inclusive) in some northern Regional Parks vehicle-based campgrounds, SCC Campgrounds and SCC Designated Parking areas and is not valid at Muriwai Regional Park all year. See SCC Pass conditions for details.

# Self-Contained Certificated Vehicle (SCC)

## Camping Pass - Conditions of use

### 1. Locations, occupants and periods of use:

#### 1.1 Permitted to stay in

- Vehicle based campgrounds, backcountry campgrounds.
- Self-containment certificate campgrounds and designated self-containment parking areas.
  - Must have a current NZC5465: Self-containment certificate that is issued by an authorised person of the Ministry for the Environment.
  - Based on the appropriate campervan, vehicle, caravan, 5th wheeler or campermatics access rules. Restrictions apply (see table at the end of this document).

#### 1.2 **No person shall camp or stay on the regional park network for longer than 14 nights in any calendar month, or longer than the permitted period on any campground, unless permitted in writing by the council.**

1.3 This Pass does not enable you to pre-book or guarantee camping space at any vehicle based campground, self-contained certificate campgrounds or designated self-containment certificate parking area.

1.4 This pass is not valid at vehicle-based campgrounds, self-containment certificate campgrounds and designated self-containment parking areas at **Tawharanui, Scandrett, Mahurangi, Wenderholm and Shakespeare** Regional Parks from 1 December to the last day in February (inclusive) and **Muriwai** Regional Park all year around. During these periods and at these locations, normal charges and procedures apply.

1.5 The pass allows for the maximum number of occupants as stated on the current NZC5465: self-containment certificate to stay in the campermatics, campervan, caravan, 5th wheeler or bus. In self-containment certificate campgrounds and designated self-containment certificate parking areas occupant numbers are not allowed to exceed this number. Vehicle based campgrounds, occupant numbers may exceed this number provided:

- Additional numbers are charged at normal camping rates.
- All normal camping procedures and conditions of use apply.

1.6 This pass can only be used for the purpose of camping. It is not able to be used for day use activities, or to gain access to campgrounds for other purposes e.g. fishing during the night and use as a bookable picnic site.

1.7 This pass is **not transferrable** to another party or person.

#### 1.8 Using the pass:

##### To check availability and book, you must:

- Phone Auckland Council Contact Centre **09 301 0101** on the day you wish to use the pass.
- Follow all Auckland Council camping procedures and conditions of use.

#### 1.9 Booking ahead

If you wish to make a confirmed booking that starts ahead of time, (e.g. for the next day or week etc.), normal camping charges, procedures and conditions of use apply.

### 2. General Condition

2.1 The pass is valid for 12 months from 1 September to 31 August. Expiry date is listed on the pass.

2.2 A current NZC5465: self-containment certificate for that vehicle **must** be displayed in the window of the self-contained vehicle, so it is visible at all times.

# Self-Contained Certificated Vehicle (SCC)

## Parking Areas and Campground - Conditions of use

1. **Must** have a current NZC5465: Self-Containment certificate that is issued by an authorised person of the Ministry for the Environment.

### 2. **Camping modes:**

Restrictions apply to Self-Contained Certificate Campgrounds and Designated Parking Areas because of ground or access conditions not suitable for size and or weight of some units. (See individual site code and conditions for details).

Use of containers and portacombs is prohibited at these locations.

### 3. **Length of Stay:**

Varies, see individual site code and conditions for details. These restrictions apply to any group or individual irrespective of booking name.

### 4. **Access:**

Self-Contained Certificate Campgrounds and Designated Parking Areas are inaccessible after main park entrance gate closing times.

Combination codes do not provide access through the main park entrance gate.

### 5. **Group bookings:**

Will not be accepted from 17th December to the last day January.

### 6. **Vehicles are not to be driven:**

Around the Self-Contained Certificate Campgrounds and Designated Parking Areas during main park gate closure hours unless in an emergency OR authorised by staff.

### 7. **Park Rangers have the authority to direct:**

Users to specific areas, request users to move, vehicles/units or equipment, stop inappropriate activities and to terminate the stay.

### 8. **Rubbish:**

**NO** bins or rubbish disposal facilities on the park – please take **ALL** rubbish home.

### 9. **Unsupervised Persons under the age of 18:**

- Persons aged 16 years and 17 years are not permitted to have a permit granted or use this site without prior consent, a completed and signed ["Unsupervised persons under the age of 18"](#) form from their legal guardian. Click on the hyperlink above to download the form.
- Persons aged 15 years and under are not permitted on or to use this site without appropriate supervision.

# General Camping Conditions

1. **Vehicles are not to be driven** around the campground or designated self-contained certificate parking area during main park gate closure hours unless in an emergency OR authorised by staff.
2. **Campgrounds are inaccessible after main park entrance gate closing times.** Combination codes do not provide access through the main park entrance gate.
3. **Combination locks** are provided at campgrounds for your safety and security. Please keep the gate closed and locked at all times.
4. **Departure /Arrival:**  
Campgrounds are to be vacated by 11:00am on day of departure. Provided there is space in the campground campers can arrive from the main park entrance gate opening time. If no space, wait until a space is available or 11:00am vacation time.
5. **Visitor vehicle parking:**  
For safety and to avoid congestion in campgrounds visitor's vehicles must park outside the campground and visitors walk from the locked gate unless prior arrangement with the Park Duty Ranger.
6. Campgrounds have no allocated or designated sites. Camp in the approved area/s within the designated campground.
7. **Marquees:**
  - Must comply with and have appropriate consents to comply with all local city or district council requirements including those for temporary buildings, noise and electrical safety codes.
  - Must comply with all Auckland Council Regional Parks: marquees rules and conditions.
8. **Day visitors:**  
Times are restricted to the main park entrance gate opening hours. Visitor numbers are restricted to: Family permit - max five group permit - max of 20% of the group size. The campground is not to be used as a day-use area.
9. Times are restricted to the main park entrance gate opening hours. Visitor numbers are restricted to: Family permit - Max five. Group permit - Max of 20% of the group size. The campground is not to be used as a day use area.
10. **Rubbish free parks:**  
Your campsite must be kept clean and tidy during your stay and on your departure.
11. Park Rangers have the authority to direct campers to specific areas, request campers to move tents, vehicles or camping equipment, stop inappropriate activities and to terminate camping.
12. **Camping modes:**
  - There may be some restrictions to vehicle based campgrounds because of ground or access conditions not suitable for size and or weight of some units.
  - Camping in containers and portacoms is prohibited.
13. **Unsupervised Persons under the age of 18:**
  - Persons aged 16 years and 17 years are not permitted to have a permit granted or use this site without prior consent, a completed and signed ["Unsupervised persons under the age of 18"](#) form from their legal guardian. Click on the hyperlink above to download the form.
  - Persons aged 15 years and under are not permitted on or to use this site without appropriate supervision. Persons aged 15 years and under are not permitted on or to use this site without appropriate supervision.
