1. On 7 October 2016, the Minister of Defence (“**the Minister**”) gave notice under section 274 of the Resource Management Act 1991 that he wished to be a party to these proceedings (“**the appeal**”).
2. Following the High Court’s decision in [2017] NZHC 2141, Bunnings Limited filed with the Environment Court an amended notice of appeal.
3. Section 274 parties to the appeal have been offered the opportunity to file amended section 274 notices in light of Bunnings Limited’s amended appeal.
4. Since filing his original section 274 notice the Minister has settled a related appeal. Accordingly, the Minister no longer has an interest in the appeal and now gives notice that he withdraws his interested party notice in the appeal.
