- 1. Pursuant to section 274 of the RMA, Westgate Joint Venture ("WJV") hereby gives notice of its wish to be party to an appeal by CNBFT against a decision of Auckland Council ("the Council") on the Auckland combined plan, now the Auckland Unitary Plan: Operative in Part, ENV-2017-AKL-156.
- 2. The appeal concerns the Council's acceptance of the Independent Hearing Panel's recommendation that it approve I610.10.1. Redhills Precinct: Precinct plan 1 ("Redhills Precinct") on 27 July 2016, and in particular the alteration of certain key transport routes through the Precinct and the amendment of their classification from collector to arterial.
- 3. WJV is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C of the RMA.
- 4. WJV made submissions and further submissions on the proposal, namely submissions and further submissions seeking the inclusion of a Precinct Plan for the area now known as the Redhills Precinct in the Unitary Plan.
