We, the Rapata Group Trust and the Eiberg Family Trust (**Trusts**), wish to be a party to an appeal by the Davies Kahlberg Family Trust (**DFT**) against a decision of the Auckland Council (**Council**) on a recommendation of the Auckland Unitary Plan Independent Hearing Panel (**Panel**) on the Auckland Unitary Plan (**Proposed Plan**) in respect of submission 2143 made by the DFT on Topic 028.

Your right to be a party to the proceedings in the Court may be limited by the trade competition provisions in section 274(1) of the RMA.

This notice must be signed by you or on your behalf.

You must serve a copy of this notice on the relevant local authority and the person who commenced the proceedings within the same 15 working day period and must serve copies of this notice on all other parties within 5 working days after that period ends.

However, you may apply to the Environment Court under section 281 of the Resource Management Act 1991 for a waiver of the above timing or service requirements (*see* Form 38).
