

Notice of Requirement by the Minister of Education to the Auckland Unitary Plan: Educational Purposes – being a Primary School (years 0 to 8) and an Early Childhood Education Centre (ECE) Centre (preschool)

Auckland Council has received a notice of requirement for a designation from Minister of Education as the Requiring Authority for educational purposes.

In summary, the requirement seeks to provide for a primary school [year 0-8] and an Early Childhood Education Centre [ECE] (pre-school). The designation will provide for construction activities associated with the proposed works and the long term operation of educational activities including a primary school and an ECE.

The site to which the requirement applies is 4.73ha comprising:-

0.09ha located at the south-eastern corner of 260 Bremner Road; 0.34ha located at the south-western corner of 160 Bremner Road; 0.29 ha located along the western boundary of 138 Bremner Road and the entire site at 41 Burberry Road, Drury.

## Making a submission on the notice of requirement

Any person or organisation may make a submission on the notice of requirement, but a person who is a trade competitor or the requiring authority may do so only if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the requirement relates that –

- (a) Adversely affects the environment; and
- (b) Does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
