The partial removal of Designation 6733 (State Highway 20 - Interchange access from Maioro St, Mt Roskill) in the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) relating to 21-23 Ernie Pinches Street and 25 Ernie Pinches Street, Mount Roskill, Auckland.

Summary

Auckland Council has received a request from Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency under section 182 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA), dated 20.07.2021, to remove in part Designation 6733 (State Highway 20 - Interchange access from Maioro St, Mt Roskill) from the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) (AUP (OP).

A section 182(1) report is required to uplift the existing designation in part from land which has been deemed surplus to requirements by Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency. The effected properties at 21-23 Ernie Pinches Street and 25 Ernie Pinches Street, Mt Roskill are zoned Residential - Terrace Housing and Apartment Building and are privately owned.

Auckland Council, as the territorial authority, is required to amend its district plan, without using the process in Schedule 1, as soon as reasonably practicable after receiving a Section 182 request, unless it considers that the effect of the removal of part of the designation on the remaining designation is more than minor. Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency has given notice to the owners/occupiers affected by the change in Designation.

It is recommended that the partial removal of Designation 6733 be accepted.

Recommendation

- That the section 182 request from Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency for the partial removal of Designation 6733 (State Highway 20 - Interchange access from Maioro St, Mt Roskill) in the Auckland Unitary Plan be accepted for the following reasons:
 - the decision to remove (in part) Designation 6733 to the extent shown in Map 3 and **Attachment A**, has been taken because these sections of the Designation are no longer required.
 - the effects of the removal of part of Designation 6733 on the remaining Designation are less than minor (s182(5)).

2. That Designation 6733 (State Highway 20 - Interchange access from Maioro St, Mt Roskill) be partially removed, as soon as reasonably practicable, from the Designation overlay in the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part).

2.0 Background

2.1 Details of designation

The Designation is contained in Chapter K of the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) and is shown as New Zealand Transport Agency Designation 6733 on the Auckland Council geospatial maps.

Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency intends to remove those parts of the Designation from the properties listed and legally described in Table 1. Designation 6733 was put in place to assist in the development of State Highway 20 and to facilitate the undertake maintenance, operation, use and improvement to the State Highway network. The decision to remove part of Designation 6733 has been taken because these sections of Designation 6733 are no longer required.

The partial up-lift of the Designation 6733 is in response to an enquiry from the property owner at 21- 23 Ernie Pinches Road, Mount Roskill. Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency has given notice to the owners/occupiers affected by the proposed changes to the Designation. (This correspondence is provided in **Attachment B**). The changes proposed to

Designation 6733 are indicated in Map 3 and covers the area between the existing blue boundary of Designation 6733 indicated on the map and the proposed yellow boundary of the Designation. The remaining area of Designations 6733 will retain its original purpose and remain unchanged. This includes access for maintenance services within the State Highway 20 area. The effects of the partial uplift will be less than minor on the existing Designation.

Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency considers that no other parties are considered affected by the uplift of the designation. Auckland Council having reviewed the AUP maps showing Designation 6733 concurs with this view.

The following land parcels shown in Table 1 are affected by the designation being up lifted.



2.3 Delegated authority to consider alterations to designations

The Team Leader – Planning, Central and South, (Plans and Places Tier 5) has delegated authority, in accordance with Schedule 2A of the Auckland Council Delegations: Chief Executive Officer (updated February 2021), to exercise the Council's functions, powers, duties and discretions under the Resource Management Act 1991 in relation to Section 182 to approve a removal of a designation. The section 182 request to remove the designation can therefore be considered by the Team Leader – Marc Dendale (Plans and Places Tier 5) and accepted or declined.

2.4 Relevant Statutory Provisions

Section 182 of the RMA allows a requiring authority to remove a designation or part of a designation if it no longer wants it. This section also applies to a notice by a territorial authority, to withdraw its own designation or part of a designation within its own district.

Section 182(2) states that as soon as reasonably practicable the territorial authority shall, without using the process in Schedule 1, amend its district plan accordingly. If the territorial authority considers that the effect of the removal of part of a designation on the remaining designation is more than minor, it may, within 20 working days of receipt of a section 182 notice, decline to remove that part of the designation.

It is considered that Waka New Zealand Transport Agency has provided sufficient justification for the partial removal of Designation 6733 (State Highway 20 in the vicinity of Earnie Pinches Street, Mt Roskill) for the following reasons:

- the decision to remove (in part) Designation 6733 to the extent shown in **Attachment** A has been taken because these sections of the Designation are no longer required.
- A request was made by one of the effected land owner for Waka Kotahi to consider whether the full Designation was still required.
- the effects of the removal of part of Designation 6733 on the remaining Designation is less than minor (s182(5)).

3.0 Recommendation

That pursuant to Section 182 of the Resource Management Act 1991 that the partial removal of Designation 6733 (State Highway 20 in the vicinity of Ernie Pinches Street, Mt Roskill) be accepted and the designation overlay in the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in part) be amended accordingly.





- 8.0 Waka Kotahi requests the territorial authority to amend the district plan accordingly as required by section 182 of the Resource Management Act 1991.




