

Auckland Unitary Plan

Mandatory Change to the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) and Auckland Council District Plan – Hauraki Gulf Islands Section (Operative 2018)

The National Policy Statement on Urban Development 2020 directs the council to remove minimum car parking rate requirements (objectives, policies, rules and assessment criteria) by 20 February 2022. This change is made without using the process in Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA).

In accordance with section 55(2A)(b) of the RMA, the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) and Auckland Council District Plan – Hauraki Gulf Islands Section (Operative 2018) was updated on 11 February 2022 to meet this mandatory requirement.
