	The Auckland Unitary Plan was updated on 11 May 2018 to advise plan users that the above legislation was now in place (the regulations came into force on 1 May 2018).	

	 This Clause 20A aims to add a heading to each text annotation which was added on 11 May 2018 to highlight which National Environment Standard it is referring to. In E11, a similar heading is also added for the existing note regarding the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Electricity Transmission Activities) Regulations 2009. Various other amendments are being made to the AUP for the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Freshwater) Regulations 2020 and the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Freshwater) Regulations 2020 and the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Freshwater) Regulations 2020 and the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Marine Aquaculture) Regulations 2020. The consistent use of headings will clarify which standard the relevant note relates to.
