Objective [rcp/dp] in the Operative in Part version to add the letter “t” therefore correcting the typographical error so that the objective makes sense: E31.2 Objective [rcp/dp] (1) <u>T</u> he risks of hazardous facilities to people, property and the environment are minimised to acceptable levels while recognising the benefits of these facilities.


