

Partial removal of a designation under section 182 of the Resource Management Act 1991

Subject: Partial removal of approximately 26,300m² of land within Designation 1839 Opaheke North-South FTN Arterial in the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) - 136, 132,128, 116 and 122 Waihoehoe Road, Drury 2113

Summary

Auckland Council has received a request from Auckland Transport (**AT**) under section 182 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (**RMA**), dated 10 December 2024, to remove approximately 26,300m² of land in Designation 1839 Opaheke North-South FTN Arterial in the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) (**AUP**). The addresses for partial designation removal are 136, 132,128, 116 and 122 Waihoehoe Road, Drury 2113.

A section 182(1) request is required to uplift the existing designation in part from land which has been deemed surplus by AT.

Auckland Council, as the territorial authority, is required to amend its district plan, without using the process in Schedule 1, as soon as reasonably practicable after receiving a section 182 request unless it considers that the effect of the removal of part of the designation on the remaining designation is more than minor.

It is recommended that the partial removal be accepted.

Recommendation

- That the section 182 request from AT for the partial removal of Designation 1839
 Opaheke North-South FTN Arterial in the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part)
 be accepted for the following reasons:
 - The extent of Designation 1839 that applies over land that has been subdivided for urban development. The extent of the designation for partial removal apply to 116, 122, 136, 132,128 Waihoehoe Road, Drury 2113.
 - Total existing area of the designation over these five sites is approximately 55,000m². The area of the land no longer required is approximately 26,300m².
- 2. That Designation 1839 Opaheke North-South FTN Arterial be partially removed, as soon as reasonably practicable, in the Designation Management Layer in the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part).



2.0 Background

2.1 Details of designation

Chapter K of the AUP identifies that Designation 1839 Opaheke North-South FTN Arterial applies to 116-140 Waihoehoe Road, Drury. The designation is for the construction, operation and maintenance of the arterial road corridor and the partial removal applies to 136, 132,128, 116 and 122 Waihoehoe Road, Drury. Figure 1 shows the existing extent of the designation in the AUP maps. The section subject to this s182 request is circled in yellow.

2.2 Land affected by removal

AT advises that part of Designation 1839 that currently applies to 136, 132,128, 116 and 122 Waihoehoe Road, Drury is no longer required for future transport purposes. See Attachment A.




Figure 2: Areial map showing portion of Designation 1839 to be removed (in pink) from the properties on Waihoehoe Road (Source: AT)

AT has provided Figure 2 (refer below) showing the portion of Designation 1839 to be removed from 136, 132,128, 116 and 122 Waihoehoe Road, Drury.

2.3 Consultation

AT advises that the developer has requested part of the designation be removed from their land, as required by section 182(1)(b) of the RMA. Only one land owner owns the designated land. See Attachment C.

3.0 Delegated authority to consider alterations to designations

The Team Leader – Planning Central/South (Planning and Resource Consents Department Tier 5) has delegated authority, in accordance with Schedule 2A of the Auckland Council Delegations: Chief Executive's Delegations Register, Version 1.7, updated October 2024, to exercise the Council's functions, powers, duties and discretions under the RMA in relation to section 182 to approve a removal of a designation.

Accordingly this section 182 request to partially remove Designation 1839 can therefore be considered by the Team Leader – Planning Central/South (Planning and Resource Consents Department Tier 5).

4.0 Relevant Statutory Provisions

Section 182 of the RMA allows a requiring authority to remove a designation or part of a designation if it no longer wants it.

Section 182(2) states that as soon as reasonably practicable the territorial authority shall, without using the process in Schedule 1, amend its district plan accordingly.

It is considered that AT have provided sufficient justification for the partial removal of Designation 1839 Opaheke North-South FTN Arterial for the following reasons:

- The extent of Designation 1839 that applies to 136, 132,128, 116 and 122
 Waihoehoe Road, Drury (LOT 1 DP 371528, LOT 2 DP 173904, LOT 3 DP 173904,
 LOT 1 DP 146189 and LOT 2 DP 146189) is no longer required for future transport
 purposes.
- The effect of the partial removal on the remaining designation will be no more than minor.

5.0 Recommendation

That pursuant to section 182 of the RMA that the partial removal of Designation 1839 Opaheke North-South FTN Arterial be **accepted** and the AUP Designation Management Layer be amended accordingly.
