Notice of application for declaration by Cato Bolam Consultants Limited: ENV-2017-AKL-000136

Auckland Council gives notice that Cato Bolam Consultants Limited has applied for a declaration under section 311 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA) in relation to the interpretation of the boundary adjustment subdivision rule E39.4.1(A4) in the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part).

The issue addressed in the application is, in general terms, whether there is “no locational requirement for a boundary adjustment subdivision under the Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part), provided other criteria are met”.

Any person who has the right to join the application under section 274 of the RMA, may become a party by giving notice within 15 working days of the date of this notice to the Environment Court, Auckland Council (Attn: mike.wakefield@aucklandcouncil.govt.nz) and Cato Bolam Consultants Limited (Attn: littlejohn@quaychambers.co.nz).
