Subject: Plan Modification: Clause 20A modifications to Auckland Unitary Plan -

Correction to Schedule 10 and D13 Notable Trees Overlay, AUP

30A Beach Road, Castor Bay - ID #1041 (removal)

A correction is required to the Auckland Unitary Plan (operative in Part) 2016 (the AUP).

I seek your approval of this plan modification pursuant to clause 20A, First Schedule, Resource Management Act 1991 (correct minor errors) and Chapter D13 Notable Trees Overlay of the AUP(OP).

You have delegated authority, as a tier four manager, to make a decision to correct a minor error to an operative plan under clause 20A. Schedule 2A of the Auckland Council Chief Executive's Delegations Register authorises all powers, functions, and duties under RMA's first schedule (except clause 17 which cannot be delegated) to tier four positions.

D13.4 Activity table of the AUP enables the automatic update of Schedule 10 Notable Trees Schedule under the following circumstances:

- a) Subdivision altering legal description of one or more trees
- b) Resource consent authorising the removal of one or more trees and the tree has been physically removed
- c) Resource consent for, or authorisation of, removal of tree as a result of emergency works (storm damage/disease/other).

In this case the modification arises from a resource consent authorising the removal of a Norfolk Island Pine tree ID 1041 which has come to light following a subdivision affecting the property the tree triangle is located on. The tree has been physically removed.

Nature of change	A clause 20A modification is required in accordance with D13.4 to update Schedule 10 of the AUP in response to a consent granted in June 2020 to remove a notable tree #1041 (TRE60342137). The consent came to light after the GIS team had advised - 4 September 2024 following the regular updating of the cadastral data received from LINZ - that a subdivision of a property containing a tree triangle had occurred (refer Attachment 1). The tree has been physically removed and the consented subdivision plan (cross lease conversion, SUB60429816) indicates that there is no tree on the property (refer Attachment 3). This has been confirmed by viewing Google Maps. This necessitates removing

Effect of change	The effects of the modifications are neutral as they are authorised by the provisions of D13.4 AUP where a tree has been removed by way of the grant of a consent (TRE60342137). There is no need for landowner advice of this correction as the tree has been down for some time (circa 2020) and it is the recent subdivision that has brought the facts to light.




