# Public Rawene Road Carpark

Waide Construction's site manager has confirmed that now that their tower crane has been removed they will be vacating 14 of the 20 carparking spaces that they have been using this year. These 14 spaces will be available again for public use from the 21st December 2018.

Unfortunately the remaining six spaces are still required by Waide Construction in order to safely hold scaffolding in place along the building and to finish the windows, external cladding, flashings, exterior painting, concrete remedials, and eventually the safe removal of scaffolding materials, backfill of the retaining wall & re-instatement of curbing. Waide have assured us that they will be progressing these as quickly as possible to return the remaining spaces. Please direct any queries about this to Waide Construction.

# Notice of work early 2019

The Phase 2 works to permanently stabilise the Rawene Reserve landslip will be undertaken early in 2019.

# **Proposed Work**

The Phase 2 work programme will comprise the construction of a below ground pile wall and installation of ground anchors at the bottom of the slope to provide a stable base, then earthworks above this to reinstate the slope to a flatter profile to that which existed prior to the landslip. This will be followed by stormwater control measures, the creation of a replacement car park and reinstatement of the service lane.

#### Duration

The works are anticipated to begin on site from 7 January 2019 and will take around five to six months to complete, weather permitting.

#### **Working Hours**

The normal hours of construction work shall be restricted to:

- Monday to Friday:
  - o 6.30am to 7.30am, low level noise activities only
  - o 7.30am to 6pm, construction work
  - o 6pm to 8pm, work can continue, but no noisy work.
- Saturday: 7.30am to 6pm
- Sundays and public holidays: No noisy construction work at any point.
