Land slip remediation activities on site Over the last four weeks trucks have been delivering fill material to the slip site. That material has been spread and levelled where necessary and we can confirm that work on the initial filling is complete. You can see from the recent photo below that a platform has been created for the piling rigs to commence works soon.



While trucks were bringing fill to site a portion of the public Rawene car park had to be closed (to assist with truck access and manoeuvring). We are pleased to let you know that those parking spaces are now available again for use by the public.

Monitoring	The site is still being monitored for movement (inclinometers) and ground water (piezometers). These are in-ground monitoring equipment that are regularly checked on-site, by our consultants with the readings and any recommendations sent to the Project Manager.
	We can confirm that there has been no movement since the sheet pile walling was installed in January 2018.

	Things are still on track to open the new carpark, in addition to the remaining portion of the old carpark, by April/May 2019.
