Resource consent application – extension of time limit

Auckland Council may under <u>section 37(1)(a)</u> of the Resource Management Act 1991 (the Act) extend time periods specified in the Act, whether or not the time period has expired.

Under <u>section 37A(4)(b)(ii)</u> of the Act, which allows a time period to be extended but not more than doubled to any time period requested or agreed by an applicant, the time period from the end of the submission period to the completion of the hearing has been extended as per the agreement contained in the email from Mr Craig Shearer dated 03 December 2021.

The time period from the end of the submission period to the completion of the hearing has been extended by nine (9) working days to be a total of 84 working days (from the original 75WD). The date the hearing must be completed by 08 April 2021.

In extending this time period, the following matters have been considered:

- The interests of any person who may be affected by the extension (including the applicant)
- The interests of the community in achieving an adequate assessment of the proposal
- Council's duty to avoid unreasonable delay.

In accordance with <u>section 37A(6)</u> of the Act, persons who have made a submission to date on the application have been identified as identified as being directly affected by this extension, beyond the applicant. These persons will be sent a copy of this letter.
